B. Sale prior to major Recess (July/Christmas)

- Based on Seller estimates, if all centres are 1 or 2 day Sales, Sale Days in all regions shall be advanced to Tuesday/Wednesday selling. If any one centre requires three days the standard program shall apply. Policy is for at least 2 centres to sell on the final day of trading.
- Subject to volumes, NASC will roster at least 2 centres on the opening day after a major Recess.

C. Wool Week

Based on Seller estimates, provided no Centre exceeds 2 days and subject to NASC authorisation, Wool Week shall be programmed for Tuesday/Wednesday selling.
