

**SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES FOR THE MEETING OF THE WOOL INDUSTRY EDP USERS
GROUP HELD ON TUESDAY THE 4th OF APRIL 2017**

SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES

1. Delivery Basis Changes

Following on from the last meeting brokers were asked to check and report back to the secretary if the changes were OK, no further codes were required.

A paper from the last meeting was submitted for further discussion. The delivery basis changes were thought to be enough and the other items listed in the paper could be removed. The field 'Auction Centre/Catalogue' needs to be looked at in terms of sorting and grouping lots for hard copy catalogues. There are multiple storage locations and PSC's on one catalogue page, it appears catalogue page no longer means anything.

It was noted that NASC had not reviewed the issue at this stage. The grouping of the catalogue should be up to buyers and brokers, it may be asking too much for commercial companies to provide information in regards to this issue.

Advice or suggestions might be needed from the group, identifying where the wool is and the PSC is critical for the buyer. It would be appropriate for WIEDPUG to prepare a short paper for the commercial companies.

An enquiry was made if any other aspects of the paper needed to be addressed? It was noted that all of the issues in the paper are related, the paper to NASC will address these issues as well. It may not be practical for reporting flag, core test sampling date and weigh date to be changed.

The changes to Delivery Basis codes with only D & L being used was presented to the broker group and they were happy with the proposed changes and did not require anything else.

2. Other Business

An enquiry was made as to whether there were any updates on the RFID trial and WSA's from the previous meeting.

The AWEX Board is considering a WA proof of concept RFID trial, if green lighted the trial will commence next season. If the trial is successful season 2018 would be the earliest for it to be released to production. There are no updates on WSA's.
